Memory Fragment Details *⊘*



Memory fragments take the form of broken glass shards that the player collects in the game environment that allows Nyla to reconstruct her memory. Players encounter these fragments by walking around in the Undergrid. To pick up a fragment, players walk into it and it will be collected. Players need to collect all the fragments in each level in order to unlock the boss level of each floor. The details of the each fragment can be viewed on the Memory Board.
