Agent Vira: "Call me if you find anything."

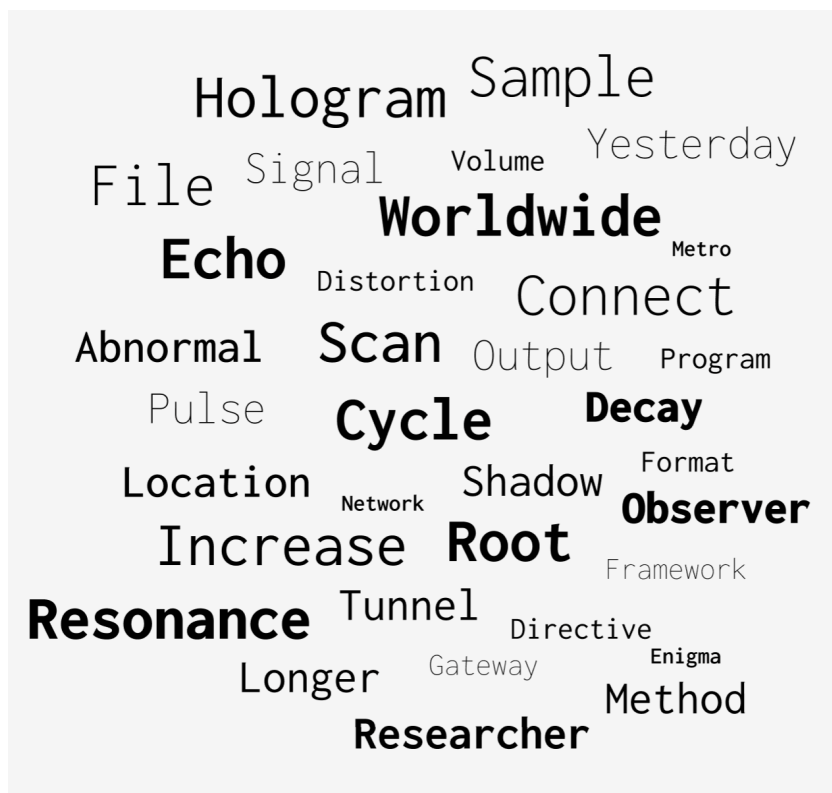
You snuck into the agency's headquarters at midnight yesterday and copied the folder onto your flash drive. You head home and attempt to open up the file, but you are met with resistance.

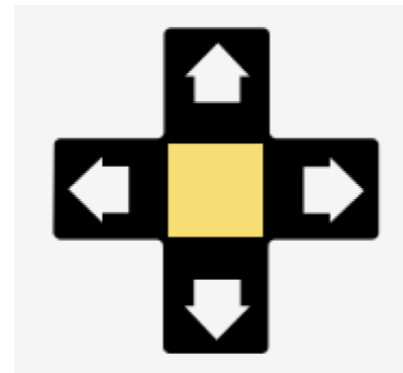

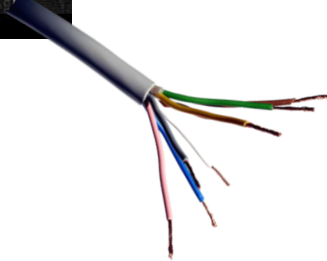
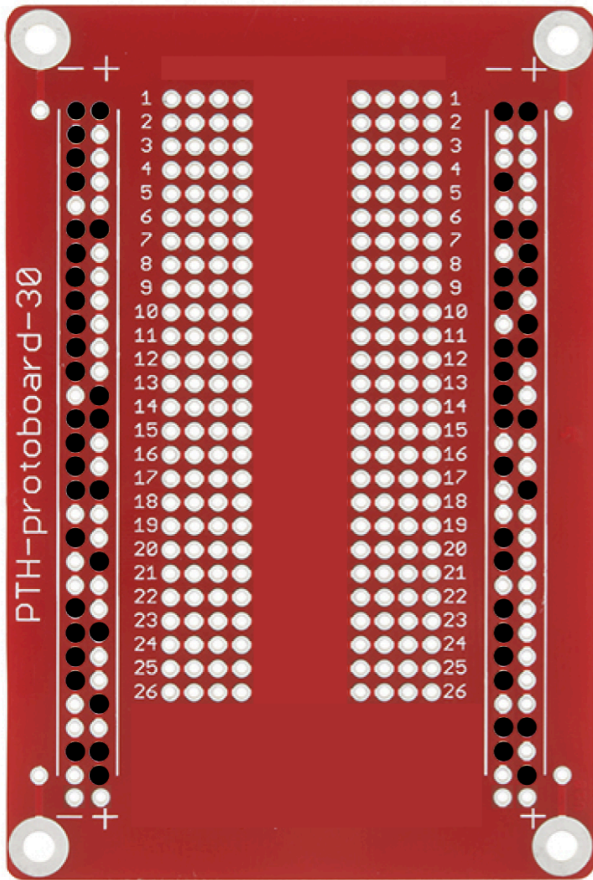
Agent Vira:

Puzzle 4: Keypad puzzle



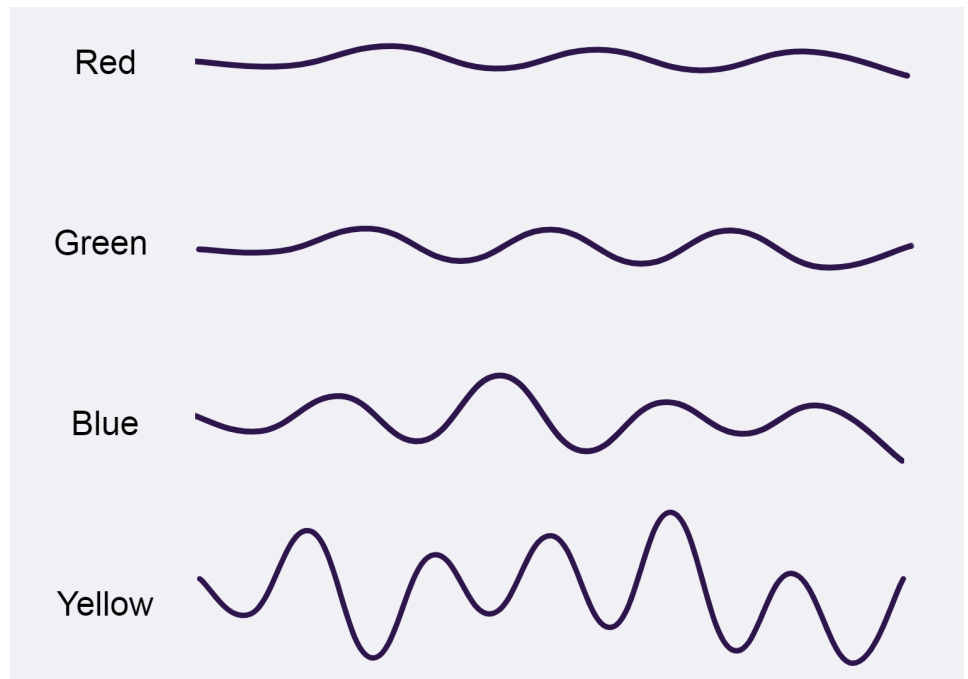
After solving puzzle:

Extraction Cube Instructions

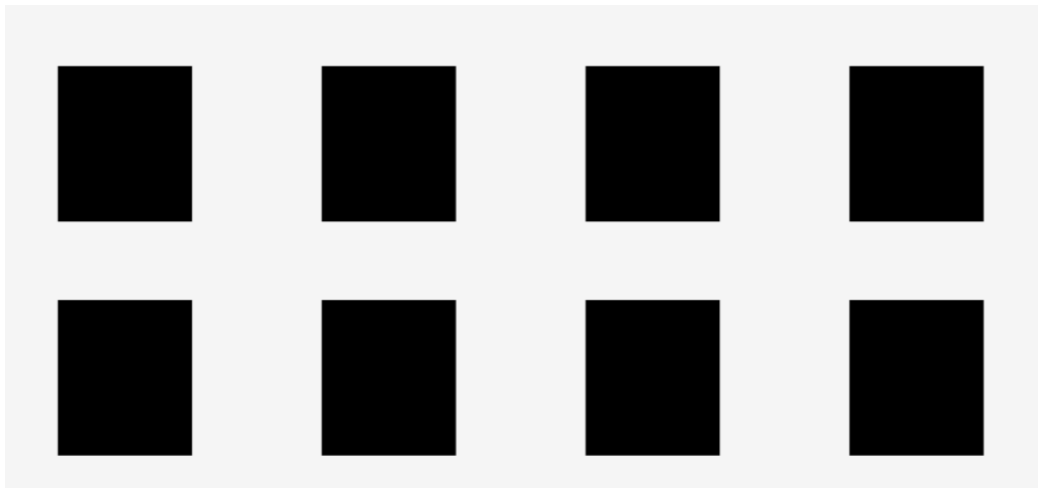
Capacity: Up to 5 liters of emotion (stored as energy).

3. Same emotion extractions must avoid proximity

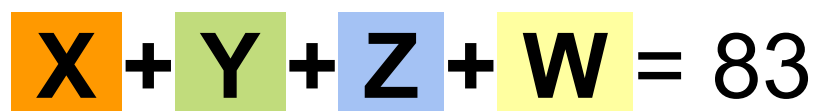


After solving puzzle:

Shit, shit, shit—they found me!"

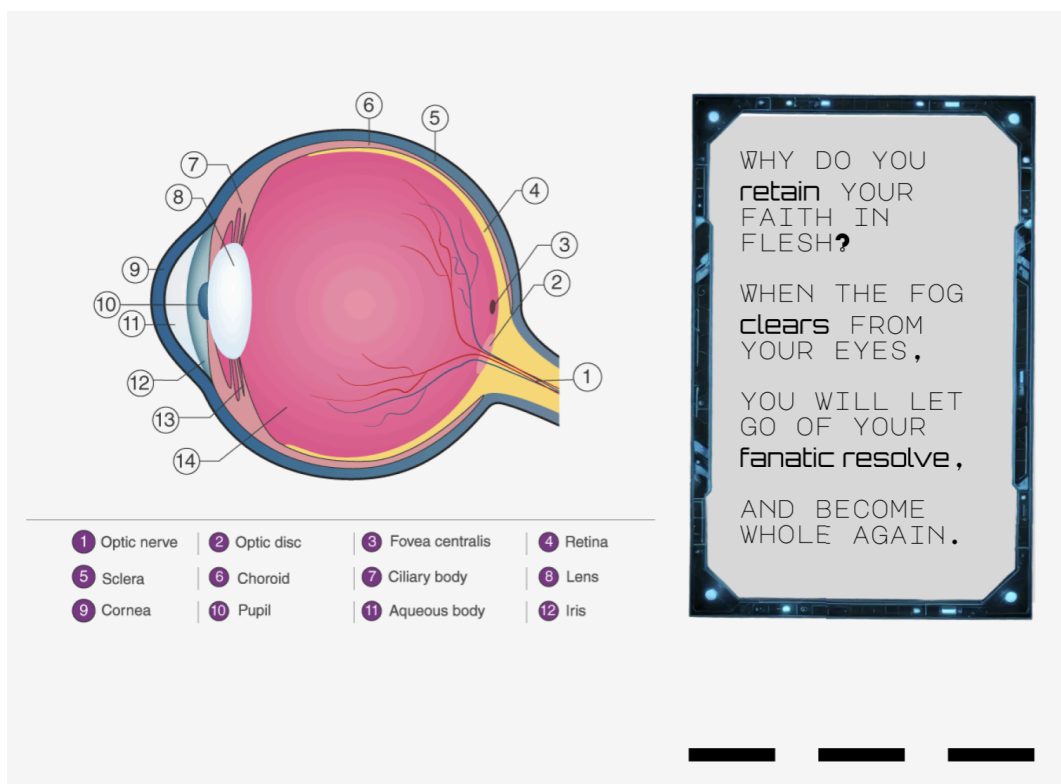
[Sounds of a struggle. Muffled screams. A sudden gunshot. Silence.]

"You didn't really think you were working under the radar, did you? We've been watching you two from the start. Letting you snoop around? That was just entertainment."

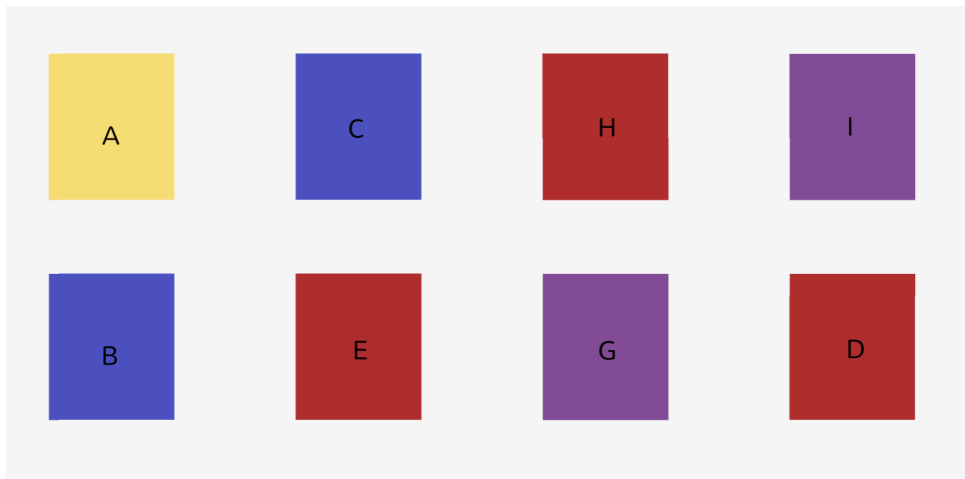
A faint metallic click pierces the air:
