Age: 17

Personality: Nyla is a girl of few words, she is cool and aloof. Her parents are often too busy to check on her, making her independent. Deep down, she actually hates being alone, but she is so used to being in solitude that it has become her comfort zone. She is strong-willed and guarded towards those she does not know. At school, she almost always has her headphones on, tuning out the teachers and others around her.

Wisteria is one of her only friends, and she sees Wisteria akin to family. Nyla however, has an inability to express warmth or kindness, which creates an emotional barrier between her and Wisty. When Wisty comes to her with good news, she masks her emotions under a passive statement like "That's cool, I guess".

When she is upset, she tends to hide. When Wisty is trying to comfort her, she sees Wisty's actions as patronizing and even suffocating.

Wants: After Wisteria's death, Nyla becomes vengeful, determined to find out who was the main perpetrator behind her suicide. She tells herself it's for justice and for the hatred she feels towards the "popular" kids at school. In reality, she wants to ease the sense of guilt she feels for not being able to prevent Wisty's death.

Needs: Nyla is the type to bottle up her emotions and not let it show, she always tells others she doesn't care. Secretly, she's envious of Wisty's perfect life and happy family. When Wisty dotes on Nyla, she sometimes can't help let some of that frustration show. Nyla needs to be able to accept vulnerability and realize that deep down, she does care.

Flaws:

Emotional Detachment - Can be emotionally blunt and say hurtful things

Jealousy - She cannot admit that she is jealous and her denial causes her inner turmoil

Stubborn - Once she decides on something, it's impossible to persuade her otherwise.
